## **SMALL BITES**

John Fenyes and wife Andi have opened a Hungarian bakery and sandwich shop, Ap-Petite, in Pasadena. Their families were close in Budapest and tried to fix up various family members over the years, but John and Andi were the only pairing to connect. Everything at Ap-Petite is "petite," and all pastries are sold by the pound to encourage variety. Expect Fig Newtonlike pastries called prune lekvar, borekas (rolls with sweetened farmer's cheese) and choceez (sweetened farmer's cheese rolled in milk chocolate, with lemon zest).
