NEW IN TOWN

Eileen Leslie and son Miles managed to lure genre-defying chef Josef Centeno to their kitchen with a forgotten Craigslist ad. The first-time Echo Park restaurateurs chose the name Lot 1 for their trapezoid-shaped space because it's the first plot on the tract of land. The cafe features black concrete floors, sidewalk tables and new art monthly. Centeno changes his global, market-driven menu even more often, depending on availability. Recent offerings included panseared quail with black garlic vinaigrette and red wine braised pot roast with cream of wheat and kumquats. At lunch, Centeno offers five bäcos — flatbread tacos — including one loaded with pork belly and beef carnitas. By late June, he hopes to incorporate brunch and spontaneous tasting menus. 1533 W.
