

SAKE BY THE GLASS

Kamotsuru Tokubetsu Junmai

Full aroma of anise that continues on the palate with complex notes of smoke and mushroom. The top ranking sake of Hiroshima and a wine connoisseur's favorite. **5**

Kamotsuru Junmai Ginjo Nigori

Fresh aroma and a hint of honey on the nose. Refreshingly sweet with well balanced acidity. **6**

Kuro Kabuto Junmai Daiginjo

Using Kuro Koji brewing, it is a well guarded secret developed over many years. It has a bold presence of sweet fragrant strawberry and rice umami, balanced with tart accents of ripe pear and apple. **7**

Dassai Junmai Daiginjo

Using the best ingredients, old fashioned experience, and cutting edge technology, the brewery staff go to extremes to create this pinnacle of refined elegance. Polished to an unprecedented and highly difficult 23% polish ratio, this sake offers a delicate fruity aroma and refined flavor. **16**

SAKE BOTTLE

Kikusui Junmai Ginjo

A sweet aroma of rose and Mandarin orange with a clean and spicy finish. From Kikusui Shuzo, the Gold Award recipient at the National Sake Competition in Japan / 300 ml **16**

Kikusui Funaguchi

Unique and one of a kind. Up to two months after production the fresh clear taste of new sake can be enjoyed. After six months the experience becomes full with richness of the brew. After ten months, a brandy-like character emerges after a year a full-bodied aged sake emerges / 300 ml **17**

Suigei Tokubetsu Junmai

Fennel, hops and unripe strawberry flavor with a hint of rose on the nose. Extremely clean, the "Drunken Whale", is for the serious sake drinkers / 300 ml **20**

BEERS

Lamill Signature: Black & Black 9

North Coast Scrimshaw

Fresh and bright pilsner with a slight hint of hops and a clean finish. **3.5**

Anderson Valley Hop Ottin IPA

Strong hop aroma with a deep, complex body. Using honey drenched malts, this gives the beer slight sweetness before the hops come through on the finish. **4**

Franziskaner Hefeweisse

Wheat malt, barley, hops, yeast and water in a traditional German style. Flavors of banana and clove. **4**
Simple and perfected over the years.

Grimbergen Dubbel

Two fermentations give it a chocolate, toffee taste with a brandy-like finish. **4**

North Coast Old Rasputin

Rich and intense imperial stout with complex flavors and a warming finish. 12 Gold Medals in various competitions, 7 in World Beer Championships. **4.25**

Allagash White

Refreshing Belgian Witbeir, generous amounts of wheat and blend of spices. **4.5**

Gouden Carolous Hopsinjoor

Triple ale brewed with 4 different hops to give it a unique, gentle, bitter finish. **8.5**

Hitachino Nest Commemorative Ale

Burnt orange color with flavors of cinnamon, orange peel, and other spices. **9**

St. Bernardus ABT 12

Quadruple ale with dark ivory color, high fermentation, soft aroma, and fruit undertones. **9.5**

Duchesse de Bourgogne

Sour ale from Belgium gets its complex flavors from the blending of 8 to 18 month old ales that's been aged in oak barrels. **10**

Ozeno Yukidoke IPA

Using five times the hops of other beers, this IPA is well balanced, with smooth flavor, mellow bitterness, and citrusy tones. This hoppy IPA is surprisingly California in style. **10**

Tama No Megumi, Bottle Condition

Bottle conditioning is the process of putting live yeast into the actual beer bottle. This process is used to continue aging the beer, even as it sits on the shelf. It can be aged for 5 years. **11**

Coedo Beniaka

Fermented for an extended period of time, this premium lager features an aromatic sweetness in its amber tones. This truly unique beer is a rare combination of high quality malts and "Beniaka", the roasted Kintoki sweet potato of the Kawagoe region. **12**
